

Vulnerability

The European Asylum Curriculum offers seven modules on the topic of vulnerability, focusing on various aspects of vulnerable groups within the asylum process. The Gender, gender identity and sexual orientation module explores the challenges faced by individuals with diverse gender identities and sexual orientations. Interviewing vulnerable people and Interviewing children provide guidance on how to conduct sensitive and appropriate interviews with vulnerable individuals, including minors. The Trafficking in human beings module addresses the specific needs and protections for victims of human trafficking.

The Applicants with diverse SOGIESC module covers asylum seekers with diverse sexual orientations, gender identities, and sex characteristics, while the Children in the asylum process module focuses on the unique needs of child applicants. Finally, Victims of gender-based violence discusses the protection and care required for individuals who have experienced gender-based violence.
