DESCRIPTION

The aim of this module is to help users of the MedCOI database understand the scope of the database and the role of MedCOI in the field of international protection. Learners should complete Basic MedCOI training before starting Advanced MedCOI training.

This module focuses on the medical country of origin information (MedCOI) database. It consists of two different learning paths: a basic module which focuses on how to search the MedCOI database and interpret information found in query responses, and an advanced module which focuses on how to develop case-specific questions and launch a MedCOI request. This module provides guidance on assessing health-related claims, an increasingly relevant aspect in protection cases.

1. Describe the scope and role of MedCOI in different procedures
2. Outline the legal standards and different practices in EU Member States
3. Explain the differences between general COI and MedCOI
